ARTICLE II. - DOGS

Sec. 14-31. - Collar and vaccination tag.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for an owner to allow any dog to run at-large within the city unless the dog shall have a substantial collar placed around its neck, by the owner, on which there shall be a metal plate with the name and address of the owner of such animal, and there shall be attached to the collar of such dog a tag showing that the dog has been properly vaccinated and immunized against rabies.
- (b) The owner of any dog shall see that the dog is wearing the required collar, at all times, with the appropriate tags attached.

Sec. 14-32. - Destruction.

The chief of police, or any other police officer of the city, shall destroy any dog found running at-large within the city, which does not have the required collar and tags properly attached to it.
